Lanes are numbered 1 to 20 (Comp) and 1 to 6 (Shallow) from the NE side (entry gate end) to the diving end.

No diving during assigned warm-up. Step in only.

No diving at any time in the warmup pool or in warmup/warnm down lanes during the meet.

Relay exchanges may be practiced <u>under the direct supervision of a team's coach</u>, if all coaches sharing a lane agree, and, the lane is not being used for laps.

<u>Invitational Finals</u> - Warmup is only for finals swimmers. Lanes will not be assigned.

The last half hour in the "finals" lanes will be controlled.

Sold and red lanes are snared. Please cooperate.

For all of warm-up except the last 1/2 hour: ALL SWIMMERS WILL ENTER THE POOL FEET FIRST AND WITH ONE HAND ON THE DECK

All Lanes (Push-off's only, NO EQUIPMENT): Swimming and Pulling only

The last 1/2 hour is controlled warm-up as follows:

Lane (both course set ups) (NO EQUIPMENT)

- Push off 50's pace (circle swimming)
- 2 Racing start one length, only sprints
- 3 Swimming and Pulling only
- 4 Swimming and Pulling only
- 5 Swimming and Pulling only
- 6 Racing start one length, only sprints
- Racing start one length, only sprints
- 8 Push off 50's pace (circle swimming)

### 2021 FPSA High School Swimming Meet

#### **General Comments on the Rules**

Rules will be 2021-22 NFHS for Non-Championship meets as amended by FHSAA. (Note: FHSAA "State Series Rules" do not apply!)

Warm-up time assignments are posted at www.FSPASwimMeet.com. Check your time before you arrive.

The **Developmental Meet** is a single session Timed Finals Meet.

The Invitational Meet has Preliminary heats (in 10 lanes) in the morning and Finals (in 8 lanes) in the evening.

NFHS Uniform rules will be enforced.

On-site shaving is not allowed at any time. Violators will be disqualified from further participation in the meet.

Visual "lap" counters for the 500 Freestyle, if used, shall be positioned on the deck at the end of the pool opposite the starting end. Only one person per is permitted at the end of each lane to operate a "lap counter" and, as the swimmer turns at the start end, they shall flip the "lap" counter to the next higher or lower odd number and show the orange card for the final length.

The breaks after the 50 freestyle and 200 Freestyle Relay (Finals Only) will be at least 5 minutes, unless determined otherwise by weather of other circumstances.

Swim-offs will be conducted within 45 mins after the last heat of the last event in which any of the swimmers competing in the swim-off have competed. All swim-off will be decided during the preliminary session. Ties will be resolved for 8th, 9th, 10th, 16th, 17th & 18th places, after any Declared False Starts (scratches). Coaches and swimmers are responsible for checking for possible swim-offs before leaving the facility.

The order of swim for a relay team must be designated on the relay card. Once called to the blocks, the first person listed must swim first. The second, third and fourth swimmers may change their order but must correct the relay card by the end of the heat. Relay Cards, with all eligible swimmers listed will be returned to teams for finals. Over entry rules will apply. Max 4 events per swimmer—no more than 2 of which may be individual events. For the "Invitational" up to 8 swimmers may be named on the Relay Card. Only those swimmers, if still eligible, may swim that relay in finals.

Swimmers not on the block when the Referee extends his/her arm to the starter will not be allowed to swim. (Note: rule states on Long Whistle – arm extending is a courtesy!)

Swimmers requesting a "Declared False Start" (scratch) from finals must inform the Head Referee (or designee) within 30 minutes of the announcement (written, announced or electronically published) of finalists so that swimoffs can be determined, and Finals can be properly seeded.

So that the meet can proceed without unnecessary delay, "Declared False Starts" in preliminary heats, or the timed finals meet, should be submitted to the Deck Referee prior to the start of the heat.

Swimmers withdrawing from any event because of injury or illness may not further participate in the meet without proper clearance by the Head Referee. (See Rule 3.2.2)

If a non-participating team member enters the water during a race, that person is disqualified from further participation and all team members participating in that race shall be disqualified.

Body markings are allowed if not excessive, objectionable, or vulgar. For the safety and comfort of other swimmers, only non-soluble marker may be used. Tattoos which are vulgar or objectionable must be covered with non-transparent tape. The Head Referee will decide whether body markings or tattoos are excessive, vulgar, or objectionable.

The use of bells, sirens, horns, whistles and any other artificial noisemakers (such as rocks in a plastic bottle) during the meet by swimmers, coaches, team assistants or spectators, is prohibited. Please advise your swimmers and supporters of this.
